Publishing ScheduleCleaner™ on Citrix Platform

After the application has been successfully installed, the following steps should be performed in order to publish ScheduleCleaner™.

Step 1

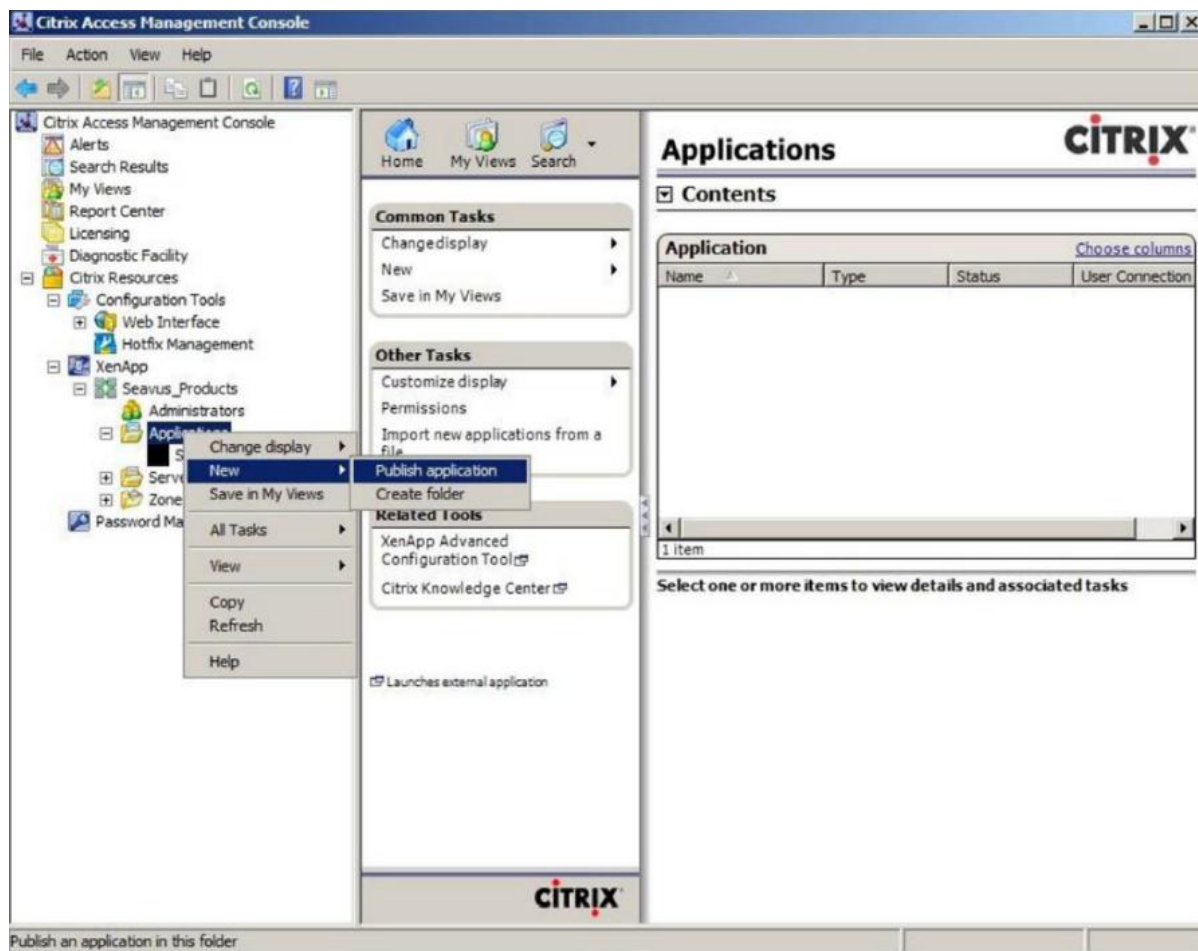
Click Start-> Programs-> Access Management Console-> Citrix Resources -> XenApp-> Name of your farm/Administrators.

Step 2

Enter an administrator account and click OK.

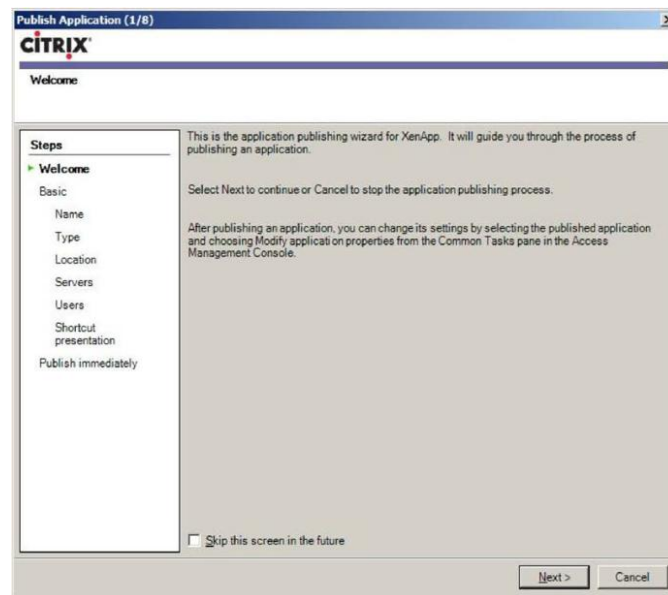
Step 3

From the list of available languages select your language in which application content will be presented.



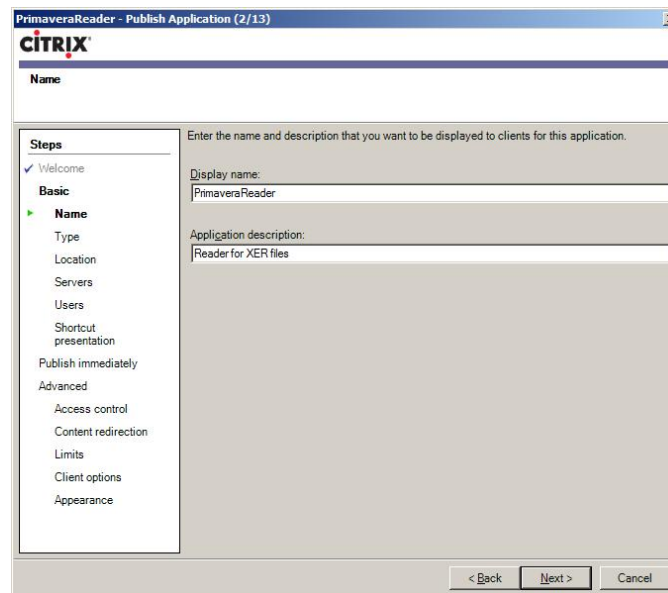
Step 4

The Publish Application Wizard appears (as shown below).



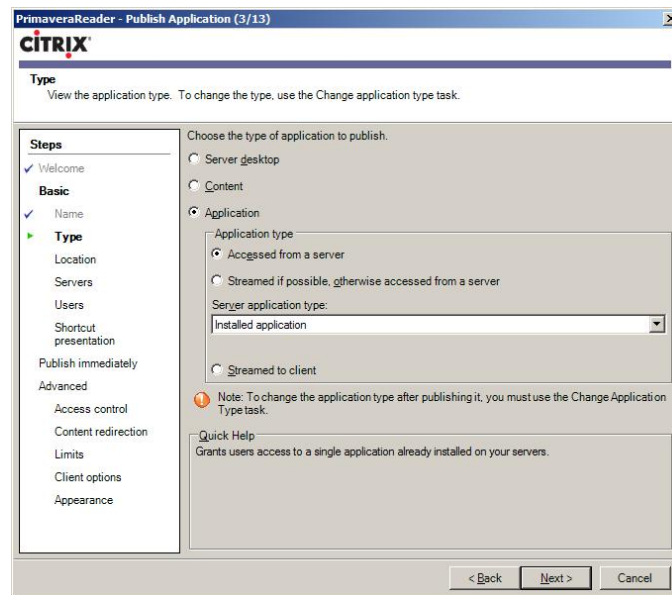
Step 5

Enter the required Display Name, entering an Application Description is optional. Then click Next.



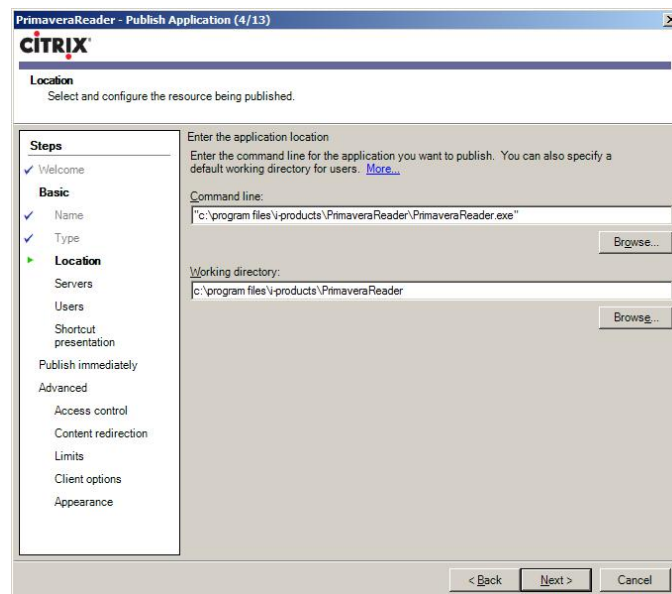
Step 6

Now you are able to publish the application executable and choose the application type.



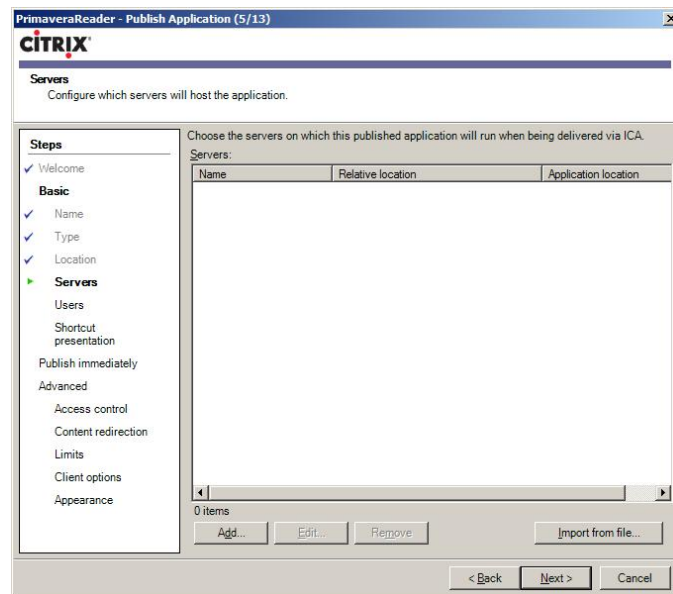
Step 7

Enter the path or browse to the application executable and click Next.



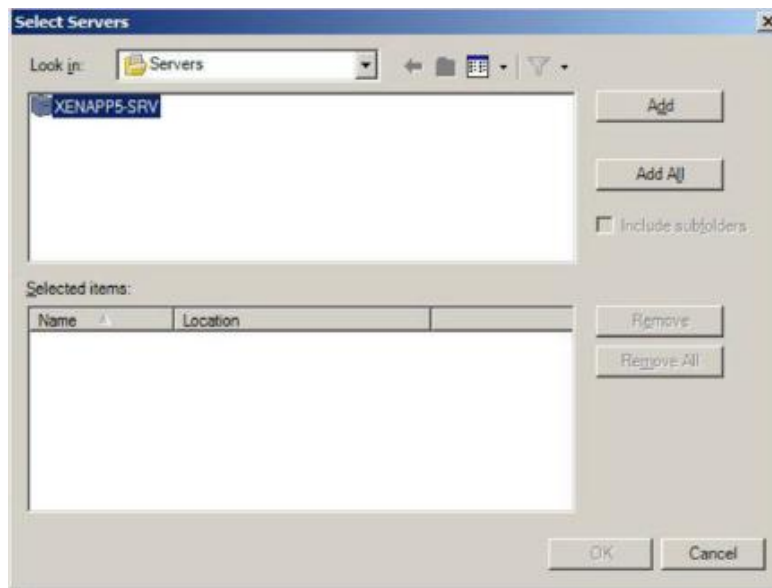
Step 8

In this step you are prompted to specify the servers on which the published application will run. To add the servers click on the Add button.



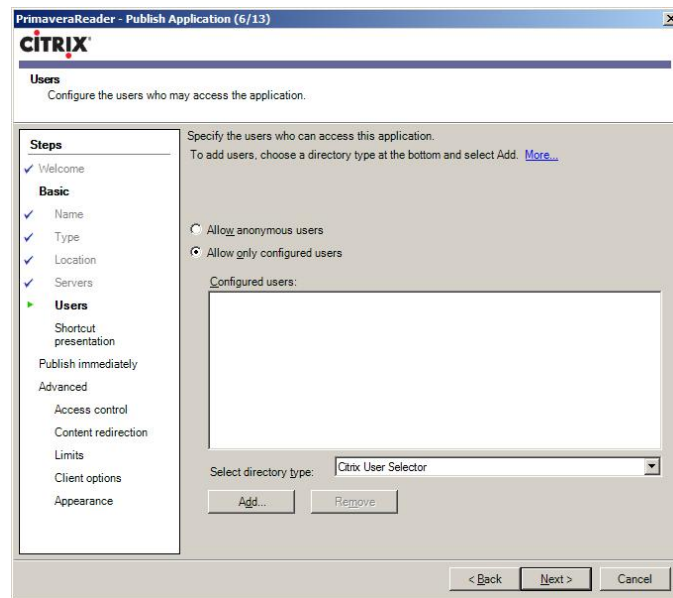
Step 9

This step will bring up to the Select Servers form, from where you can select the desired servers in the list. After all required servers are added, click on the Ok button.



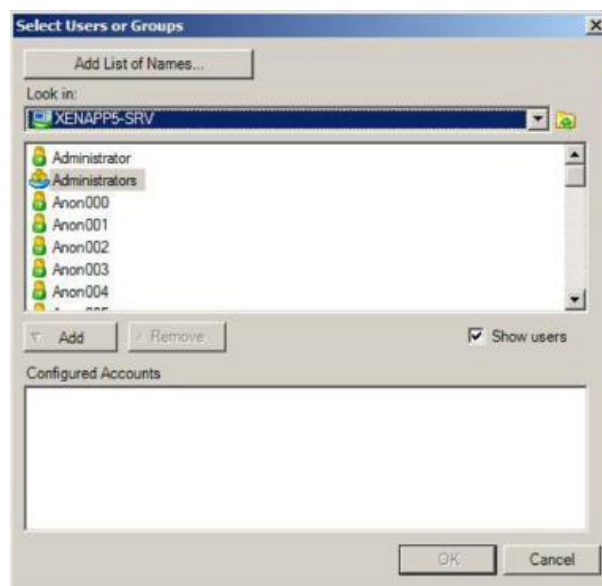
Step 10

The next screen will ask you to specify the users and groups that have access to the published application. By clicking on the Add button, you can add the users who will have access to ScheduleCleaner™.

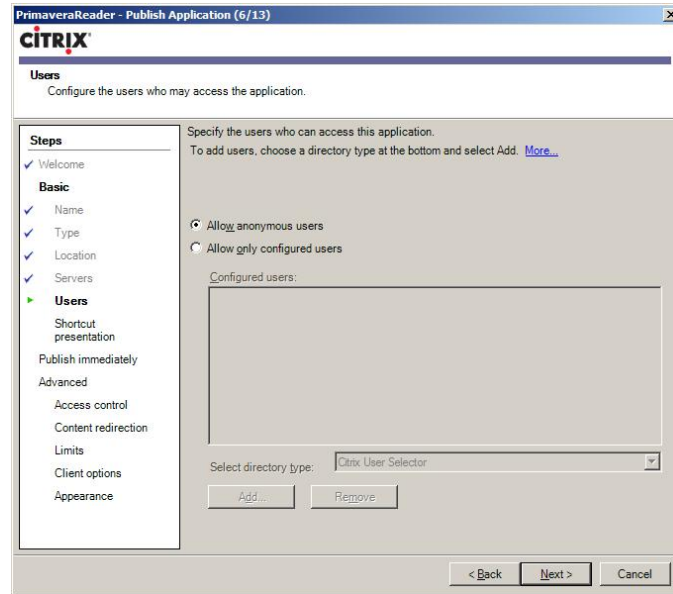


Step 11

From the Available Account list box, highlight the users and/or the groups you would like to give access to the application. Click Add for adding them to the Configured Accounts list box. When finished click Ok.

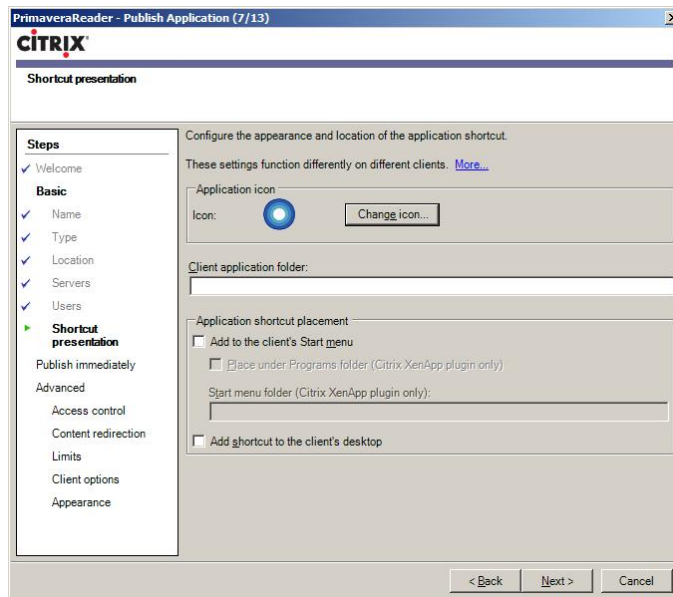


Note: If you like, you may allow Anonymous Connections.



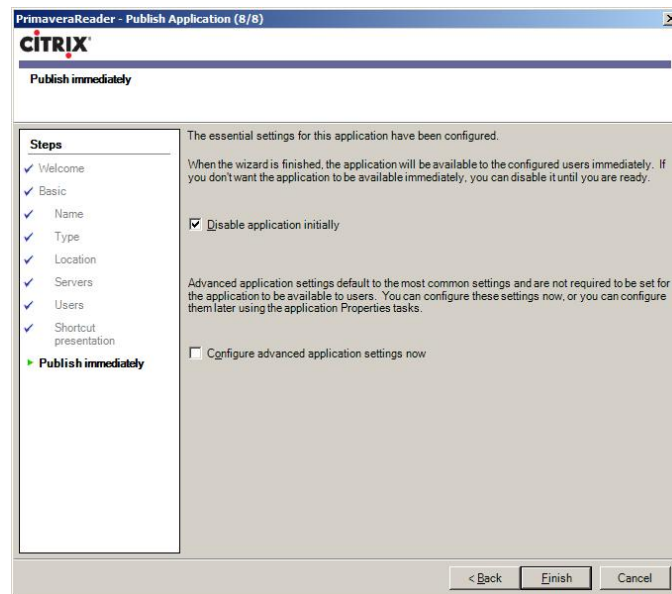
Step 12

Now you can configure the appearance and location of the application shortcut.



Step 13

The essential settings for ScheduleCleaner™ have been configured. If you click on Finish, ScheduleCleaner™ will be immediately published.



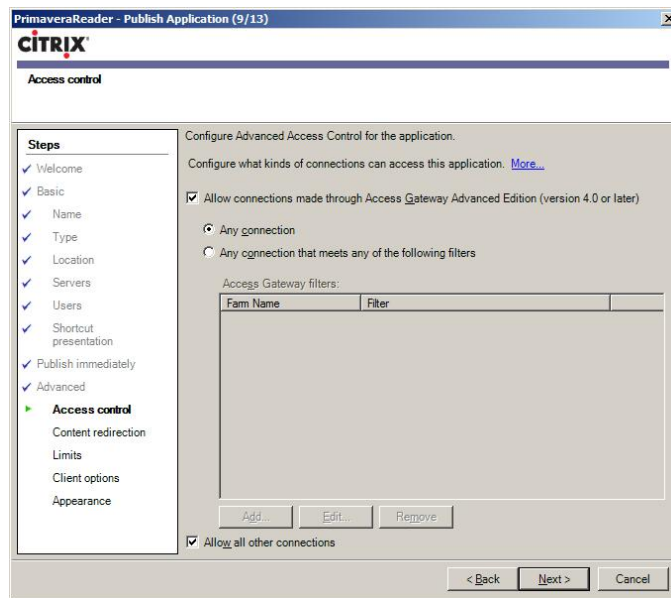
Step 14

However, there are additional (advanced) settings which you may configure while publishing the application, by selecting the “Configure advanced application settings now” using the application Properties tasks.



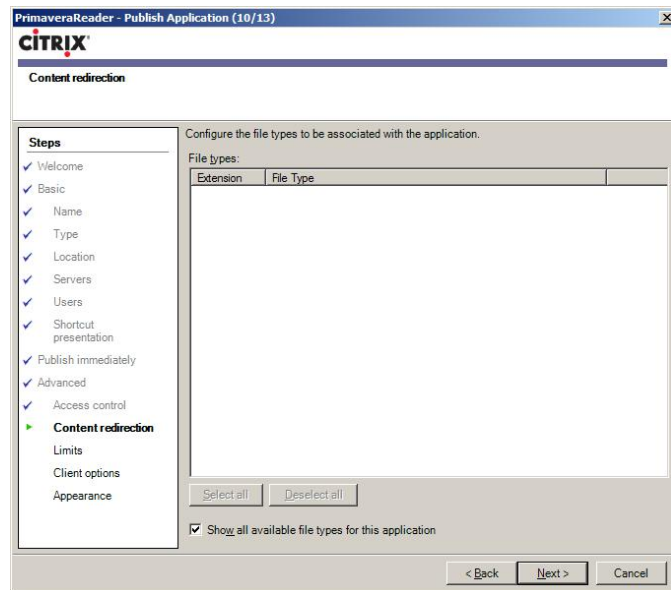
Step 15

If you choose to configure the advanced application settings, the first setting will be the Advanced Access Control. In this step you can choose who will have access to the application – if you want to allow Any (incoming) connection or if the connection should meet some criteria before access is granted.



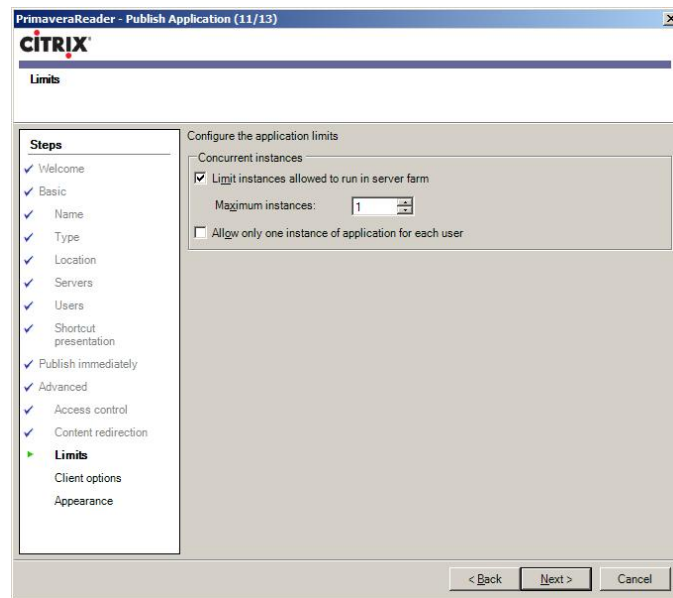
Step 16

In this step, you can configure the file types which should be associated with ScheduleCleaner™.



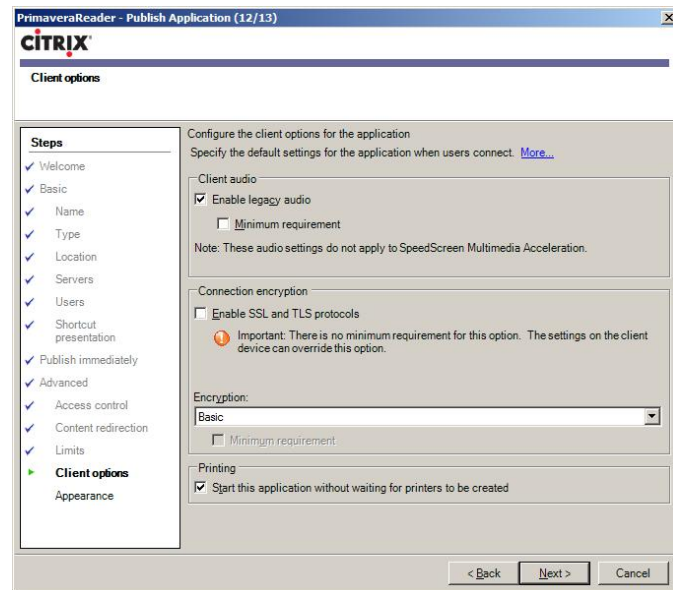
Step 17

In this part of the advanced settings, you can set limit of instances allowed to run in the server farm. Depending on your configuration, you can insert any number here, but it must not exceed the number of purchased ScheduleCleaner™ licenses.



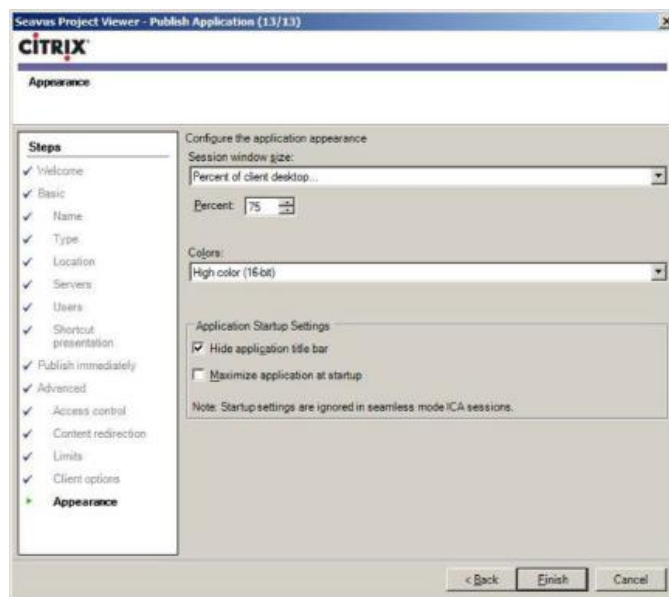
Step 18

Select to enable or disable legacy audio. Select Basic in the Encryption drop-down box and click Next.



Step 19

The last step of the advanced settings prior publishing, is to specify the application appearance. In the Session Window Size drop-down box, select Percent of client desktop. In the Colors drop-down box, select High Color (16 bit). Check the Hide application title bar check box and click Finish



You have successfully published the application that will be accessible through application portal.

Step 20

In order to be able to use ScheduleCleaner™, the clients should log in using their credentials. If Anonymous connections are allowed, the client should choose Anonymous as Logon type.



Once the client logs on, the connection is created, the client should start the application by clicking on the ScheduleCleaner™ icon.
